

Launch of e-LLM in Tanzania by UKTA , ITU and OUT

On 21st July 2008 the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), United Kingdom Telecommunications Academy (UKTA) and the Open University of Tanzania (OUT) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to facilitate the transfer of knowledge of ICT Regulation from the United Kingdom to Africa.

The ITU-UKTA-OUT (Open University of Tanzania) MoU on *'knowledge transfer'* is now active and the first programme an e-LLM, commenced with the Chairman of the UKTA Prof David Mellor OBE providing a Seminar from 2nd to 5th February 2009.

The opening ceremony in Morogoro was attended by the Vice Chancellor (Tolly Mbwette) and Permanent Secretary from the Ministry of Communications. Eleven delegates attended the programme which had been launched as a seminar owing to the delay in receiving comments from the Ministry of Education. A full cohort will commence September 2009 when back to back Seminars on 'Legal Management of Contracts' and 'Telecommunications Policy and Regulation' are to be presented by Prof Mellor.
